509/21 Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held 15th December 2021

The minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council held on 15th December 2021 were approved and confirmed as a true record.

510/21 Police Matters

There were no police matters to report from the parish council

511/21 Report of County Councillor

Councillor Barron extended his condolences in respect of the recent tragic news of the assault on ex Councillor Ken Walker and the murder of his wife.

He reported that he had spoken with the PCC in respect of the dangerous racing on the A617. He had also had discussions with highways concerning improved signage the length of the A617.

He referred to the Care home consultation, details of which had been distributed to members, and encouraged everyone to have their say regarding the proposals. Consultation closed on 4th March

512/21 Doe Lea Centre

The Manager had submitted his apologies but had submitted a report which is attached to the minutes of this meeting. No matters were raised.

513/21 Neighbourhood Plan

The Chair referred to the proposals they had drafted for submission to the consultant in relation to the Neighbourhood Plan. The proposals centred around the fact that the parish was bounded on nearly all sides by development in adjacent parishes, emphasising the importance of retaining open spaces within the parish to act as a health and leisure resource.

Members were extremely supportive of these draft suggestions. Members were asked to let the Clerk have any further proposals for the following week in order to pass them to the consultant.

Future Investment in Community Facilities

It was agreed that this item be deferred

Ramp

The Clerk was still awaiting a report from BDC as to whether the survey had been commissioned on the site

Recreation Ground

It was agreed that the Clerk put together some proposals and ideas with some costings, for the provision of a 5 a side pitch with car parking, solar floodlighting and seating/covered areas for young people.

Queen's Jubilee Event

It was generally agreed that an event would be one of the best ways of celebrating the Platinum Jubilee and that the Parish Council could join forces with the Doe Lea Centre and Bramley Vale School. Other ideas included dedicating the area leased from DCC on the other side of the A617 as a Jubilee Ground.

516/21 Applications for Grant Aid

Communication had been received from Bramley Vale School concerning a family experiencing hardship, and requesting the parish council's assistance. It was Proposed Seconded and Resolved that a grant of £500 be made to Bramley Vale School to be used exclusively as a hardship fund to support any school child identified by them as experiencing hardship.

Budget and Precept 2022/2023

Members considered the setting of the precept for 2022/2023. It was Proposed, Seconded and Resolved that a precept of £40,500 be levied which was a 1.25% increase on the previous year's figure and a 0.17% increase on the cost to a Band D property.
