1329/25 Apologies for Absence

Apologies for absence were received from Councillors T Clough, I Grainger Grimes, and R Hill Harmsworth and Councillors J Ritchie, C Tite and T Kirkham, BDC

1330/25 Declaration of Interests

There were no declarations of interest

1331/25 Exclusion of Public

No additional items were identified for exclusion of public

1332/25 Public Forum

1 member of the public was present and they outlined a project that Bramley Vale School was seeking funding for, asked about repairs to areas of Willow Walk offering assistance if required, enquired about a community garden area over the river in Doe Lea (this was identified as being in NEDDC area), suggested the installation of a fence across the footpath at the bottom of the hill on Bramley Road where it joins the A617, as this could be extremely dangerous, particularly in the winter when the surface was icy. Members were aware of another matter he reported concerning the setting of fires in the old farmhouse at Doe Lea. This had been reported on several occasions to the police and to the BDC rangers.

1333/25 Minutes of Parish Council Meeting held 9th September 2025

The minutes of the meeting of the Parish Council meeting held on 9th September 2025 were approved and confirmed as a true record.

1334/25 Police Matters

No police were present.

1335/25 Report of County Councillor

The County Councillor was not present.

1336/25 Report of District Councillor

District Councillor J Ritchie submitted his apologies but submitted a written report covering issues regarding, Local Government reform, Problems with Pleasley Mills, Clowne Garden Village Scheme, Great Wolf water park and new responsibilities for the mayor.

1337/25 Doe Lea Centre – Report of Manager to Trustees

The Manager gave an oral report to members. He had met with the Chair and Vice Chair following his return from paternity leave and a full staff meeting would be taking place on Friday 17th October. A Trustees meeting was scheduled for Monday 10th November.

1338/25 Football Field – Request for skip

The Clerk reported that Doe Lea FC had requested the provision of a skip at the recreation area so that they could tidy out the changing rooms. It was agreed that the parish council meet the cost of the skip and that the football club be asked if they would be prepared to contribute.

1339/25 Improvements to Junction 29

The Clerk circulated documentation from Councillor Suzy Cornwell from North East Derbyshire District Council who provided correspondence with Natalie Fleet MP concerning a request to consider improvements to the traffic management at Junction 29. Members were of the opinion that there was a problem with traffic flow but that this required some expert assessment to determine the most effective solution. They agreed that they would support the principle that the problem required some attention.
